Judges have the right to place entrants in an alternative category, if they deem necessary. Finalists will be notified and asked to provide additional information if required by the Judging Panel. The Judges' decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into. Confidentiality - The information contained in this entry will remain confidential and will only be accessible to the Judging
